

FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

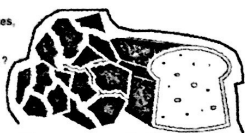
A SINGLE RIGHTEOUS ACT

It gives his explanation of what the Church would later call "Original Sin". The selfishness of Adam, the first human, brought about a pollution of the human race. The result of this sin was death for all who followed Adam. Even those who did not commit a serious sin suffered from the corruption of humanity. Paul teaches that Jesus is the new Adam. His unselfish death on the cross has removed the effects of the sin of Adam. Paul uses the term "just" to refer to the right (or correct) relationship with God that has been restored by Jesus.

His mission was to test human beings to strengthen their faith. Eventually he was seen as the ultimate adversary, the tempter of all humanity. He soon to be known as the "Devil", from a Greek word that means "one who slanders".

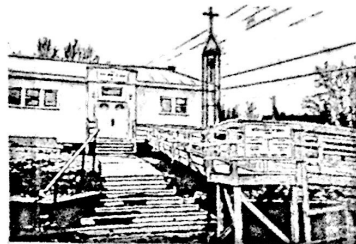
