HOW TO ACCESS LIVE DAILY MASS VIA EWTN

During this time, we wanted to remind everyone that EWTN broadcasts the Daily Mass LIVE at 8:00am ET from Our Lady of the Angels Chapel on the EWTN campus. It is re-aired at Noon ET and again at 7:00pm ET. It can be watched on TV or online via streaming at ewtn.com/tv/watch-live. It can also be watched via the EWTN mobile app.

Parishioners can also listen to the Mass LIVE on the radio via SIRIUS/XM (Ch 130), or listen online at ewtn.com/radio/listen-live or via mobile.
