♦ **A QUESTION RE OFFERING ENVELOPES**

At the request of a parishioner we would like to explain which portion of the parish's revenue stays here and which goes to the Diocese.

The offerings you give in the white envelopes are used primarily to support Sacred Heart church and its pastor.

That being said each parish in the diocese has a financial obligation towards the Hearst-Moosonee diocese, which is comprised of:

- A Diocesan Tax or Levy of 7.5% charged on the parish's revenue for a given year. As an example for 2020, our Diocesan Tax was levied at \$17,942.35 based on the 2018 year (ie \$239,231.32 x 7.5%). This amount is broken down at \$1,495.19 per month. The blue envelopes in your Offering box help to defray this expense. Should the offerings from the blue envelopes not be sufficient to cover the Diocesan tax for that month the parish will cover the difference.
