Beginning Friday, February 26, 2021 and every Friday thereafter during Lent, we will have mass at 7pm followed by the Stations of the Cross for anyone who wishes to take part. All are welcome!

♦ **LENT: A FRIENDLY REMINDER**

There is some confusion regarding the Church's requirements for fasting and abstinence during Lent. Here is a recap to clear up any misconceptions: All Catholics 14 years or older must abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays during Lent and Good Friday.

Adults 18 to 59 years of age are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. 'Fast' means only one full meatless meal plus 2 light meals, providing one's health and ability are not adversely affected. Eating between meals is not permitted, except for liquids.

Sundays in Lent are exempted from the Lenten observances of fasting and abstinence.

Penance, prayer and almsgiving (works of charity) are required by all the Christian faithful during Lent. For instance one may give up small pleasures (chocolate, TV), bad habits (smoking, alcohol, gossip) or any other penance deemed appropriate. A blessed Lent to one and all!
