He discovered that those who held firm were prisoners who believed that their lives - and hence their sufferings - had «ultimate meaning.» Dr Frankl concluded that faith gave prisoners a remarkable energy and power.

Jesus makes himself known

Since the death of Jesus on the cross, the eleven Apostles and their companions have lived a deep sorrow.

When two disciples, returning from Emmaus, are reporting to the Eleven their meeting with Jesus, who is alive and well, someone is there among them who sends them a greeting of peace. *"Look at my hands and my feet; it is me!"*

He eats grilled fish with them. He has become quite different: he appears and disappears... He becomes invisible, but always present, in the manner of God.

Jesus opens their minds...

The resurrection of Lazarus could be observed by all, but the resurrection of Jesus can only be recognized by the one who believes and meets him. To awaken the Paschal faith, Jesus opens the minds of his people to the understanding of the Scriptures, which goes further than they had understood until then. The Scriptures allow them to interpret what they experience on the occasion of the apparitions of Jesus and they give the words to bear witness to it.

Become witnesses.

Jesus awakens them to faith and invites them to a new existence, that of witnesses of the resurrection for all nations.

Saint Joseph and the Vocation

God looks on the heart (cf. 1 Sam16:7), and in Saint Joseph he recognized the heart of a father, able to give and generate life in the midst of daily routines. Vocations have this same goal: to beget and renew lives every day. The Lord desires to shape the hearts of fathers and mothers: hearts that are open, capable of great initiatives, generous in self-giving, compassionate in comforting anxieties and steadfast in strengthening hopes. The priesthood and the consecrated life greatly need these qualities nowadays, in times marked by fragility but also by the sufferings due to the pandemic, which has spawned uncertainties and fears about the future and the very meaning of life. Saint Joseph comes to meet us in his gentle way, as one of "the saints next door". At the same time, his strong witness can guide us on the journey.

Saint Joseph suggests to us *three key words* for each individual's vocation. *The first is dream.* Everyone dreams of finding fulfillment in life. We rightly nurture great hopes, lofty aspirations that ephemeral goals –like success, money and entertainment –cannot satisfy. If we were to ask people to express in one word their life's dream, it would not be difficult to imagine the answer: *"to be loved"*. It is love that gives meaning to life, because it reveals life's mystery. Indeed, *we only have life if we give it; we truly possess it only if we generously give it away.* Saint Joseph has much to tell us in this regard, because, through the dreams that God inspired in him, he made of his life a gift.
