To understand better

Easter is «passage»

We are invited to keep in our memory that the word Easter means "passage". It is indeed the passage of God. First of all to creation: the transition from nothingness to the universe, and especially to the human being. Then, the Exodus, the passage from slavery in Egypt to liberation. By raising Jesus crucified, God the Father completes the passage from death to life. This is our Easter!

Halleluia!

This Easter word corresponds to a Hebrew expression which means «to praise Yahweh». It is an acclamation addressed to God who does great things.

Easter Vigil

It represents both the summit and the heart of the liturgical year. This ceremony unfolds in a succession of movements of great depth: the blessing of the new fire to which is lit the paschal candle, Christ, the proclamation of the texts of the Old Testament and the New, the sacraments of Christian initiation celebrated for catechumens, the baptismal profession of faith of the whole assembly, etc. In short, in this vigil all the exultation and hope of the Church that celebrates the Lord Jesus who died and rose.
